Rolling Knob Press is the fine art publishing component of the IU Southeast Printmaking program, which brings professional artists and educators from across the US to create new work in our studio. From start to finish, students of all skill levels learn new processes to help artists realize their projects. The ability to assist artists in the realization of their own artwork is a practice that is highly-valued within graduate programs, professional printmaking studios, and fine art publishers, each of which require printmakers to display a breadth of technical abilities and leadership skills in the studio.

In 2016, Rolling Knob created an edition of original prints with Nick Satinover, head of the Printmaking department at Middle Tennessee State University. Students learned new processes in lithography and archival collage, and helped him print an edition of seven prints, titled *Three Days in New Albany*.
